What we performed:

- 44 Live Cases.
- The POEM (PerOral Endoscopic Myotomy) procedure for the treatment of achalasia: a new and revolutionary endoscopic procedure with a substantially reduced impact on post-operative pain and recovery time.
- New diagnostic technologies such as EUS (Endoscopic Ultrasonography) with contrast and elastography to rule out pancreatic cancer.
- The mini-invasive endoscopic approach to neoplastic lesions of the stomach and colon performed by international experts using state-of-the-art ESD (Endoscopic Submucosal Dissection) endoscopic devices allowing a more precise assessment from the pathologist, reducing the risk of tumor recurrence and avoiding a more invasive surgical approach for the patient.
- Barrett's Esophagus, a pre-cancerous condition, was ablated with endoscopically-applied radiofrequency.
- EUS-guided choledocho-duodenostomy with a new type of metal stent.
- ERCP cases were carried-out also using new cholangioscopes with improved image quality, simplifying the diagnostic approach to biliary diseases.
